



The Cedarwood faculty and staff put in significant work during the summer preparing for a school year with distance learning and the addition of emergency child care. Cedarwood's budget was based on 229 students and we ended the year with 241 students. The work put in prior to the start of the school year and continued full program offerings was a major reason for the gain in students during the year. We also received a second round of PPP funding, this enabled us to retain all of the current staff and add additional faculty and faculty assistants for distance learning and emergency child care. The community of families contributed greatly by reaching our lofty annual appeal goal and exceeding the auction goal. All of these efforts by the family community and staff have allowed us to continue on a strong path and keep our community together heading into the next school year.
